**E-Waste Management:** The College uses various types of electronic gadgets like – computers, printers, LCD projectors etc. These products become outdated after few years due to advancement in technology. Institute being aware of e-Waste and its hazards takes initiative to dispose e-waste in proper way.



#### 7.1.4 Water Conservation

Rain water harvesting has been an integral part of the infrastructure at the campus and is used to collect water from rainfall events. The quantity of water collected depends on the quantity of rainfall and frequency of rainfall in Wadwani. The size and shape of the collection structures has been designed to collect water in the most efficient way.

Rain water harvesting is practiced in the our campus since its inception contributing to recharging the ground water levels. The artificial technique of collecting water from roof-tops and open areas of the campus helps in the process of water conservation by not allowing

excess surface water from flowing to drains. This not only helps in increasing groundwater level, but also helps in improving ground water quality. In our campus including students, faculty members and administrative staffs brings the principle of “Saving Water, Saving the Earth!” in practice. To save water, the campus believe in making the people aware about the importance of water. Regular sensitization for the importance of water are done among students using several forums including seminar/webinar, invited talks, observing the World Water Day etc

The institute work out the time bound strategies to implement green campus initiatives.
